New Flexible Denture Material

We have been trialing a new flexible material, Myerson Duraflex, and have been very impressed. It is virtually as flexible as Valplast and Flexite Plus but comes in more, and arguably better, shades. Along with all of the normal benefits of flexible dentures it is also more resistant to scratching, staining and discolorations.

Adjustments

It is also possible to add teeth and make various adjustments using the same material, unlike Valplast and Flexite Plus. Whilst there are some limitations to the adjustments possible it does make this material far more versatile.

Gum Shades

Myerson produce a gum shade tab which is ideal for making sure you choose the best match for your patient. There is currently a nominal charge for the shade guides but we are looking into this to see whether we can do something about the charge.

provide UltraSuction now UltraSuction dentures have been described as the next best thing when dental implants are unsuitable or impractical. This is because of the increased stability provided by UltraSuction dentures compared to normal, conventional dentures.

How is this tighter fit achieved?

The UltraSuction system holds dentures in place by creating pressure differences between the appliance and the soft tissue. Air is expelled through tiny unidirectional valves as the patient bites down or swallows, resulting in a tighter fit and an improved resistance to dislodging forces.

The UltraSuction system is also designed to reinforce the tight fit every time the patient bites down or swallows; expelling more air from beneath the appliance.

Suitability



UltraSuction dentures are available for full restorations and work best with minimal ridges, normally some of the most difficult restorations. Generally private treatment, they are cost effective when compared to alternative restorations.
